Note: United historically had limited operations at **John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK)**, but most services shifted over time to Newark and

## Services Provided in the New York Area

### Airport Staff Services

At any of the airports where United operates in the New York area (especially **EWR** and **LGA**), United staff can assist you with:

- **Flight Check-In & Boarding** — issuing boarding passes and checking travel documents
- **Reservations & Ticketing Changes** — modifying or cancelling bookings
- **Baggage Assistance** — checked luggage, delayed/missing baggage reports
- **Flight Changes & Irregular Operations** — rebooking flights due to cancellations or delays
- **Special Needs Support** — wheelchair assistance, unaccompanied minors, etc.

These services are offered at **United's ticket counter or customer service desk** inside the airport terminals on the day of travel.

## United's Presence at Local Airports

Here's how United's New York area travel support generally works:

## EWR – Newark Liberty International Airport

- This is United Airlines' primary *hub* in the New York region.
- Extensive check-in counters, lounge services (United Club), and customer support are available.
- Most domestic and many international United flights from the New York area depart from EWR.

## LGA – LaGuardia Airport

- United Airlines operates a ticket counter and customer service desk here for scheduled flights. ([www.AirlinesOfficeHub.com](http://www.AirlinesOfficeHub.com))
- Good option for short-haul and domestic travel.

## JFK – John F. Kennedy International Airport

- Some listings associate the Old Rockaway Blvd address with JFK support, but **United's flight operations are currently limited at JFK compared to EWR and LGA.** ([airlinesofficedesk.com](http://airlinesofficedesk.com))
- Future partnerships may expand United's presence at JFK. ([AP News](#))
